BRIEF HISTORY OF THE ORGANIZATION:

With the initiative of few young people of Khardah and its surrounding villages of Amta-I Block in the district of Howrah a new chapter was opened in the year 1990. Primarily it was a club for sports & cultural activities for the local youth which became a social development organization in the ensuing years. The youth members of the club realized their responsibilities not only to kick the football but also to roll the football in continuous process for developmental goal of their people in the area. The area is predominantly inhabited by the people of Scheduled Caste and Muslim community. Their backwardness in the social point coupled with prejudice, illiteracy, squalor and fatalism turned their switch off in the economic front too. In the year 1993 the club was registered in the name of Khardah Public Cultural & Welfare Association. KPCWA in short form. Since its registration, the youth with their own contribution and subscriptions from the members continued to serve people in the form of distributing books, organizing integration camps, helping poor students with coaching, helping widow and the old, distributing clothes, food etc. among the needy people of the area. Slowly various programmes were undertaken in collaboration with different Govt. & Non-Govt. Organizations for comprehensive development of people of the area.

From 1998 onwards the strategies began to transform from giving to participations of the people for planning of their destiny. The association gave more emphasis to the women and children as they are considered to be top priority sector. Hence, self help groups formations of women, their skill training and their holistic development had emerged as most salient sector of KPCWA's work. However it also had environment and education to concretize rural poor. The journey has just started for KPCWA and the goal is far reaching.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT TRAINING OF MINORITY WOMEN UNDER "NAI ROSHNI"

Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India pleased sanctioned 7 nos. Leadership Development Training Programme of Minority Women under "NAI ROSHNI-2017-18" scheme for the benefit



of Minority Women. This financial year 2019-2020, KPCWA was organized 2 nos. of training programme at (1) Banban Jagadishpur Sishubikash Kendra under Tehatta Kantaberia-I Gram Panchayat from 02.08.19 to 07.08.19 (2) Moulana Jamal Uddin Siddikia High Madrasa under Tehatta Kantaberia-II Gram Panchayat from 21.08.19 to 26.08.19 under Uluberia-II Development Block in Howrah district of West Bengal during this span of time.



At first KPCWA has notified for selection of the trainees at all identified gram panchayat areas under identified blocks were taken into confidence for identified of potential 25 nos. Minority Women &

Girls for participation in the each training programme of 6 days duration held at different strategic places in cooperation with local administration and in consultation with district administration. Subject covered of these training programme were Advocacy for Social and Behavioral Change, Digital Literacy, Leadership of Women, Life Skill, Swachh Bharat Mission, Health & Hygiene, Nutrition, Family Planning, Domestic Violence, Mother & Child Health and information about government flagship program for benefit of the people etc. by lecture, discussion, role play, focused group discussion, chart display, power point presentation. Women of the target community were found very happy to participate in these trainings programme to learn as well as to share their problems of daily life.

Handholding programme after complete the training:

As per guideline of Ministry of Minority Affairs under "Nai Roshni" Scheme, our organization has been conducting meeting once time per month at local area by our expert resource person with the benefited trainees. In the meeting, trainees were discussed

about training modules and various issues/problems of the area. Every trainee has been given their opinion in the handholding meeting on how to change their lifestyle. Our resource



person has been nurturing the trainees group every month. This financial year 7 nos. of handholding meeting at Banban Jagadishpur Sishubikash Kendra, Tehatta Kantaberia-I, Uluberia, 4 nos. of handholding meeting at Moulana Jamal Uddin Siddikia High Madrasa, Rajkhola, Tehatta Kantaberia-II, Uluberia, 5 nos. of handholding meeting at Bahira High School, Bahira, 10 nos. of handholding meeting at Matangini Sangha, Khanpur, Hatuna-I, Bagnan and 12 nos. of handholding meeting at the training Hall Maheshpur GP, Maheshpur, Uluberia. In total 41 nos. of handholding meeting was done.

SKILL TRAINING PROGRAMME UNDER "UTKARSH BANGLA"

In this financial year our organization has organized 4 batches of Skill Training on Hnd Embroiderer & Self Employed Tailor Trade of apparel sector under UTKARSH BANGLA scheme under Paschimbanga Society for Skill Development (PBSSD), Technical Education, Training & Skill Development Department, Govt. of West Bengal, for employment opportunity to the Unemployed Youth.



(1) 3 batches of 85 days duration (340 hours) skill Training on Self Employed Tailor under UTKARSH BANGLA scheme for 30 nos of beneficiaries for each

batch including one batch under SWOPNO BHOR Prakaipa for the KANYASHREE girls at training hall of our organization under Amta-I Development Block in Howrah District.

(2) 1 batch of 50 days duration (200 hours) skill Training on Hand Embroiderer under UTKARSH BANGLA scheme for 30 nos of beneficiaries at training hall of our organization under Amta-I Development Block in Howrah District.





SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING UNDER SHG&SE DEPARTMENT

This financial year our organization was organized eight nos. of skill development training programme on Batik Print, Advance Batik Print, Food Processing, Fast Food making, Jute Bag Making, Readymade Garments Making, Sanitary Napkin Making, Sarf, Phynyle & Liquid Soap Making Training for benefits of the members of WSHG Collaboration with Amta-I, Bagnan-I & II, Shyampur-I, Uluberia-II Development Block & Uluberia Sub Divisoin Office in Howrah district with the help of Self Help Group & Self Employed (SHG & SE) Department, Government of West Bengal for the self reliance, self employment and employment opportunities among the rural people.

Under Amta-I Development Block Area

1) Sarf , Phynyle & Liquid Soap Making Training:

30 days duration Skill development training on Sarf , Phynyle & Liquid Soap Making was organized at the Training Hall of Sirajbati Loknath Sangha under Amta-I Development Block under Howrah District Collaboration with Amta-I Development Block . 30 nos of trainees from identified SHGs are learned about to make Sarf , Phynyle & Liquid Soap etc.



Under Bagnan-I Development Block Area

2) Training on Batik Print



30 days duration Skill development training on Batik Print Making was organized at the Training Hall of Bagnan-I Mahila Bikash Samiti Co. Operative Ltd. under Bagnan-I Development Block under Howrah District Collaboration with Bagnan-I Development Block . 30 nos of trainees from identified SHGs are learned about to make Batik Print on Various types of cloth material like Dupatta, Scarf, Sari, Hankerchief, Bed Cover Blouse Piece etc.

3) Training on Jute Bag Making

30 days duration Skill development training on Jute Bag Making was organized at the Training Hall of Harop Welfare Society Library. under Bagnan-I Development Block under Howrah District Collaboration with Bagnan-I Development Block . 30 nos of trainees from identified SHGs are learned about to make various types of Jute Bag like Ladies side bag, Shopping Bag, Ladies Purse, Side Sling Bag etc.

4) Training on Fast food Making and Catering Servicing

30 days duration Skill development training on Fast food Making and Catering Servicing was organized at the Training Hall Bantul Baidyanathpur Flood Centre under Bagnan-II Development Block under Howrah District Collaboration with Bagnan-II Development Block . 30 nos of trainees from identified SHGs are learned about to Cook various types Fast food and also learned how to serve.



Under Shyampur-I Development Block Area

5) Training on Readymade Garments

30 days duration Skill development training on Readymade Garments was organized at the Training Hall nabagram Baghini Sangha under Shyampur-I Development Block under Howrah District Collaboration with Shyampur-I Development Block . 30 nos of trainees from identified SHGs are learned about to make various types of Garments like Frock, Salwar , Top, Kurti, Nighty, Blouse, Petycote etc. After the training Programme most of the trainees engage themselves for Self employment as a Tailor.

6) Training on Advance Batik Print

30 days duration Skill development training on Advance Batik Print Making was organized at the Training Hall of Kanai Lal Chakraborty Memorial Hall under Uluberia-II Development Block under Howrah District Collaboration with Uluberia-II Development Block . 30 nos of trainees from identified SHGs are learned about to make Advance level Batik Print in various types of designs on Various types of cloth material like Dupatta, Scarf, Sari, Hankerchief, Bed Cover Blouse Piece etc.



7) Training on Food Processing

30 days duration Skill development training on Food Processing was organized at the Training Hall of A.D.A. office under Uluberia-II Development Block under Howrah District Collaboration with Uluberia-II Development Block . 30 nos of trainees from identified SHGs are learned about to Process various types of foods like Green Mango Squash, Jam & Jelly, Chili & Capsicum Squash, Guava Jam & Jelly, Apple Jam, Papaya and Pine Apple Jam & Jelly Mixed Fruit Jam Tomato Sauce Mixed Squash etc.



Under Uluberia Subdivision Area

8) Training on Sanitary Napkin Making



30 days duration Skill development training on Sanitary Napkin Making was organized at the Training Hall of Sishu Aloy Open Shelter under Uluberia Subdivision under Howrah District Collaboration with Uluberia Subdivision. 30 nos of trainees from identified SHGs are learned about to Process and make Sanitary Napkin in different sizes.

JUTE INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT SCHEME (JIDS) TCPC :

In the last financial year (FY2018-2019) our organization established a Training Cum Production Centre (TCPC) under Jute Integrated Development Scheme (JIDS) at Khardah Bhagabati Devi Sangha, Khardah, Amta, Howrah in West Bengal for sustainable development of Jute collaboration with National Jute Board, Ministry of Textile, Govt. of India. Now 12 nos. of trainees are making various designated jute fancy bag at production center of our organization and they earn money to help their family.

CRECHE PROGRAMME (NCS)

This scheme has been implementing by KPCWA collaboration with Directorate of ICDS, Department of Women & Child and Social Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal and Ministry of Women & Child, Govt. of India since last more than twelve years for the benefit of working mothers of economically disadvantaged communities.



At present our organization has been running seven crèche centers, two at Khardah Gram Panchayat, one each at Sirajbati & Udang-I Gram Panchyat under Amta-I Block, one at Tapna Gram Panchat under Uluberia-I Block and one each at Ward No.-28 & Ward No.-20 under



Uluberia Municipality area of Howrah District in West Bengal. 25 nos. children in each crèche centre, Altogether 175 numbers of children, both boys and girls got enrolled in these centers. Apart from basic pre-primary education, they are given nutritious food regularly and health checkup services by registered medical practitioners in periodic intervals and also have sleeping facility, sports equipments. Mothers are found very happy to see their children growing in these centers.

OPEN SHELTER (HOME)

In the last financial year Ministry of Women & Child Development, Government of India has sanctioned to run an Open Shelter for 25 nos.



of boy child under the Integrated Child Protection Scheme at Ward No.-25, Uluberia Municipality, Howrah District for the children in need in urban and semi-urban areas to provide care, support and rehabilitation for their holistic development. The purpose of the scheme is to create systems that will efficiently and effectively protect children. It is based on the cardinal principles of "Protection of child rights" and "Best interest of the child". Open Shelters in urban and semi-urban areas cater to all children in need of care and protection particularly beggars, street and working children, rag pickers, small vendors, street performers, orphaned, deserted, trafficked and run-away children, children of migrant population and any other vulnerable group of children Their age group of 6 – 18 years. The scheme essentially targets the homeless and street children ensuring protection of their rights and mainstreaming in the society by creating accessibility of developmental services to them.

We took various activities to attract above-mentioned target group of children from their present vulnerable life situation to a safe environment.



Regular awareness and Counseling are arranged to guide these children away from high risk and socially deviant behaviors and prepared an Individual Care Plan for each child, which will be monitored by the DCPS from time to time.

Our staffs and outreach workers are actively working to provide opportunities for education and develop their potential and talent. We happily announce that total 20 nos. children are enrolled in govt. school for mainstream education and carrying out regular follow up to ensure

that children do not return to vulnerable situations.

To enhance life-skills and reduce their vulnerabilities to exploitation we are organizing Various workshops like art & Craft, Drama etc in regular basis.



And also providing and feel them a safe space where they can play, use their time productively and engage themselves in creative activities through music, dance, drama, yoga & meditation, computers, indoor and outdoor games, etc.

To provide opportunity to people with skills and time to mentor, guide and improve the quality of life of these children we encourage the involvement of social workers, community volunteers, peer educators, students and others and Providing them health care facilities and refer if required for specialized services for prevention of drug and substance abuse, HIV/AIDS/STIs and other chronic health disorders.

SCHEME FOR ADOLESCENCE GIRL (SAG KP)

This financial year the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Government of India has sanctioned our organization for implementation of Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) for out of girls in the age group of 11-14 years under Bagan-I Development Block under Howrah District, West Bengal.

The key objective of the scheme is to facilitate, educate and empower Adolescent Girls so as to enable them to become self-reliant and aware citizens.

We took various activities to enable the Adolescent Girls for self-development and empowerment.

Promote awareness about health, hygiene, nutrition to improve their nutrition and health status and also to upgrade their home-based skills and life skills.

Support out of school AG to successfully transition back to formal schooling or bridge learning / skill training. Provide them information/guidance about existing public services such as Primary Health Centers, Rural Hospitals/CHCs, Post Office, Bank, Police Station, etc.



FAMILY COUNSELING CENTER

Family Counseling Center has been starting from the year 2013, at present the Family Counseling Center is running at S.D.O Office, SE/SHG Building, Raghunathpur, Purulia, West Bengal, Pin Code- 723133 collaboration with Central Social Welfare Board, Govt. of India and West Bengal Social Welfare Board, Govt. of West Bengal.

The Family Counseling Centre has been provide counseling, referral and rehabilitative services to women and children who are victims of atrocities, family maladjustments and social ostracism and also provide crisis intervention and trauma counseling in case of natural disasters. The Centre has been provided Awareness programme, Mohalla Meeting and mobilize public opinion on social issues affecting status of women at grass root level. The FCC cases close collaboration with the local administration, police, courts, free legal aid cells and psychiatric institutions, vocational training centre, short stay homes etc.



During this financial year many case treat and solve with the help of our two counselors like Domestic Violence- 15 cases, Alcoholism/ Drug Addition-2 cases, Marital Maladjustment

Spouse & In-laws-7 cases, Personality difference-1 cases, Economic crises- 2 cases, Extra Marital relation-7 cases, Depression- 1 cases, and Family property dispute- 2 case. Total -45 nos. of cases was solved and 45 nos. of cases pending out of total 99 cases but running for solving by the counselors.

SANITARY MART PROGRAMME:

KPCWA is an empanel organization of Howrah district for district level Sanitary Mart programme under SBM and MGNREGA. This financial year our organization has constructed 68 nos. of Individuals House Hold Latrine

(IHHL) under MGNREGA at Khardah Gram Panchayet under Amta-I Development Block in the district of Howrah. Organization also conducted awareness programme about mission of Swachha Bharat at various Gram Panchayat area under Amta-I Development block. The main objectives of this programme are Swachha Bharat, Clean India and Healthy India.



CHARITABLE DISPENSARY

KPCWA has been running this charitable dispensary for a long time to give health services to the needy people of Khardah Gram Panchayat and Udang-I Gram Panchayats of Amta- I Block, Haturia-I Gram Panchayet of Bagnan-I block and Tulsiberia Gram Panchayat of Uluberia-II Block in Howrah district around 4 km radius. Registered medical practitioner visit this center thrice in a week (Sunday, Monday & Thursday) from 3.00 P.M. to 6.00 P.M. for diagnosis of diseases of the patients and distribute medicines almost free of cost. This financial year near about 1667 nos. of poor and needy people of that area got benefited their health services during this span of time. Substantial support is given by Sitaram Jindal Foundation to run this center.

ROGI SAHAYATA KENDRA

KPCWA has been running three nos. of Rogi Sahayata Kendra one at Brindabanpur BPHC under Uluberia-II Block, Joypur BPHC under Amta-II Block and Bagnan Rural Hospital under Bagnan-I Block in Howrah District with the help of our two Rogi Sahayaks in each Kendra since last four years collaboration with office of the CMOH- Howrah, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal. The main objectives of the project are to help of the patient party and to set up information centre at the respective health facility, admission and treatment of RSBY and Swasthya Sathi patients in BPHC/RH by our Rogi Sahayaks on helpdesk. This financial year 98 nos. of patients availed facilities at Brindabanpur BPHC, 93 nos. of patients availed facility at Joypur BPHC and 947 nos. of patients availed facility at Bagnan Rural Hospital under RSBY and Swasthya Sathi Scheme.



YOGA CENTER (Vivekananda Yoga Center):

KPCWA has been running a Yoga Center namely "Vivekananda Yoga Center" at our organization premises from 21st June, 2015 on the occasion of International Yoga Day. This financial



year 46 nos. of trainees from 6 to 15 aged children has been yoga practice two days per week by our expert yoga trainer.

PROMOTION OF SELF HELP GROUP (SHG) PROGRAMME

KPCWA has started promotion of Self Help Group (SHG) programme with thrift savings, micro credit through bank linkage in the year 1998 for economically help to the poor and needy peoples in all categories of its operational areas to break out the vicious cycle of poverty. Bank savings accounts of all groups were opened at different bank branches. They have been generating saving and receiving credit from bank. Many members of all groups were skilled through skill development training programme collaboration with, DC(H), NJB, Department of SHG&SE and various agencies of both Govt. of West Bengal and Govt. of India. Our organization has done involved Swasthya Sathi Programme of Government among the Self Help Group's members in our operational area to take health related services. Not only that our staff members also nurturing every groups and given handholding support twice in a month.

MICRO INSURANCE FOR THE POOR IN COLLABORATION WITH LIC, GoI

KPCWA has been running micro insurance program for the poor peoples in collaboration with Life Insurance Corporation of India, Howrah division. The main objective of the program is life assurance cover through life insurance policy for the whole poor & needy people in India. Most of the people who are daily wage earners, servants, construction workers, rickshaw-pullers or lived in the margin of poverty line cannot insure their life by any Macro policy, these Micro insurance policies give assurance to insure their

life and thus their Family will be benefitted.

This financial year, 25 numbers of new policies were sold and by the end of 31st March, 2020, almost 6986 nos. of peoples of our operational villages under identified blocks in Howrah district were brought under Micro Insurance programme. Nominees of 2 nos. of policy holders got death claim money, 104 nos. of policy holders got maturity claim and 135 nos. of policies were surrendered for various reasons.

ART CENTER

KPCWA has been running an Art Center at our organization premises from 1st January, 2016. This financial year 34 nos. of children has been enrolled at our art center and they have been learning drawing one day per week by our specialist drawing teacher.

AWARENESS GENERATION PROGRAMME

KPCWA is also working for the Women so that organization has organized one awareness programme on women Empowerment at Khardah Bhagaboti Devi Sangha under Amta-I Block in Howrah district with active participants from deferent trade trainee of Utkarsha Bangla & SHG & SE Training.

KPCWA is also working for the children so that organization has organized one awareness programme on Child Rights and Right to Education at Ward No.-25 under Uluberia Municipality in Howrah district with active participants from identify particularly beggars, street and working children, rag pickers, small vendors, street performers, orphaned child. It also gives family counseling services to the Child mother.

This financial year our organization organized an awareness programme on Health & Sanitation at our Meeting Hall under Khardah Gram Panchayat under Amta-I Panchayat Samity with active participants of common villagers.

This financial year our organization organized an awareness on Water Conservation programme at Khardah Madrasah Shiksha Kendra under Khardah Gram Panchayat under Amta-I Panchayat Samity with active participants of said shiksh Kendra students.

KHARDAH PUBLIC LIBRARY

It was a long standing demand of local youth for starting one such library for furtherance of their studies in schools and colleges. Accordingly, KPCWA started this library since last seven years. This financial year District Library Officer, Department of Library, Govt. of West Bengal has sanctioned financial assistance for development of Khardah Public Library. Community peoples, students are encouraged to make use this center every day.

Livelihood Development Programme under CSR Project

Our Livelihoods Development Programme (LDP), supported by the (JSWCL) for livelihood Development at Salboni in the district of Paschim Medinipur, that aimed at improving the livelihoods of small land holder farmers, women providing for their households and youth seeking self-employment. The program consisted of enhancing access to financial services to all three segments; and for smallholders - improving agronomic practices for higher productivity, introduction of postharvest practices to protect the produce, local value addition for better Prices, strengthening the links in the value chains by linking them to markets, and for women and youth- training on entrepreneurship development to improve their business skills.



Improved farm & non-farm practice and capacity building of Farmers

• Introducing improved agricultural practice to augment the agricultural income and capacity building of Farmers:

In this financial year KPCWA took various initiatives for improvement of scientific agriculture practice of farmers and Introducing with new crops and Introducing with various cash crops to improve income of the farmers and for support them to increase high yield from their own cultivated crops. Training and capacity building Program on improved agriculture practice for farmers, Land treatment and hand holding support to farmers for better production were organized. We tried for better market linkage to ensure the price of the agro product. And made liaison with Banks for credit Linkage & linkage with Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) & other Govt. Scheme.

• Converting land from mono-crop to multi-crop & Introducing commercial Vegetable cultivation

Like previous year in this financial year KPCWA took different activities for Converting land from mono-crop to multi-crop & Introducing commercial Vegetable cultivation

As well as commercial vegetable cultivation in the area . to increase small land holder's farmers' income, the multi-crop land area, and to increase the number of farmers to use the organic manure & bio-pesticide in their own land.

- 1) Training of farmers: To impart scientific technique of commercially viable vegetable cultivation, various training programmes; pocket meetings organized for the farmers.
- 2) Handholding support for vegetable cultivation: On field guidance and handholding support has been given to the farmers which include and preparation, seed treatment, disease treatment through integrated pest management (IPM), market linkage etc.

■ Improve livelihood through non-farm practices:

For Improvement of livelihood through non-farm practices KPCWA organized Capacity building training on animal rearing for SHG members and community people and also give Handholding support to the members including the vaccination support to improve skill on animal rearing and for Help of the farmers to increase productivity and reduce the mortality rate



❖ Empowering women through SHG promotion & village entrepreneurship development

■ KPCWA always work for Women Development by empowering them through SHG promotion & village entrepreneurship development. We took various activities like Awareness generation programme for SHGs., Capacity building training, Revamping of de-functioned SHGs.

We organize Training programme and hand holding support for SHGs women focusing book keeping, credit linkage, skill development on agriculture, gottary, Phenyl, Liquid Soap and Sal Leaf Plate making etc.

We also work for Link them with Govt. Schemes (Swarojgar Yojana, SRLM Program etc.).

Success story of Debi Das and Munna Das

The is a Success Story Of Debi Das and Munna Das. They got married 9 years ago and lived happily with other family members.After two years, Debi became physically ill (thyroid is diagnosed),so, she is unable to finish housework in the given time and also unable to conceive. For this reason Debi's in-laws family started to mentally tortured her and Debi's family (Fathers House) several times try solve this problem with the help of relatives, neighbors, and local political persons. On 08/10/2019 Debi's in-laws family stigmatized her (Debi) and compared her with a bitch.In this regard, the honour of Devi Das is tarnished by all. Debi's husband Munna Das try to beat her and also made a chaos situation in their family. Debi somehow escaped and went to local police station with the request to solve her problem and she complained against her in-in-laws family members. Then the police called both families in Police Station.In the presence of family members the Police Officials try to solve their problem. In front of Police Officials, everyone accepts their own fault and promised that they lived peacefully. After returning from the Police Station, neither Munna and his family members didn't speak with Debi and her family members nor they (Munna's family) didn't take Debi with them. So, she went

to her father house. After few months, Debi and her family got worried because Munna's and his family had further contact with Debi and Debi's family. Then Debi's family contacted with Munna and his family. But they refused to take Debi in their family and also talk about separation with give back to all the gifts and money they had taken during their marriage. After hearing this, Debi became mentally ill. In this situation, Debi Dad came to Family Counselling Centre along with her grandfather on 18/10/2019 to solve her problem. She elaborately discussed her problem before the Counsellors. After hearing her problem Counsellor can understand that she is emotionally brake down and also feels helpless.So, the Counsellors heard Debi's problem and called Munna Das along with his family.In this way, the Counsellors Counsellor them in several sitting and helped them to understand the roots of their problem. At last Debi Das and Munna Das both understood their own fault and promised that they did not repeat this kind of mistakes. Then they agreed to live happily and peacefully and the Counsellors reconciled them.

Now Debi Das is better than before in her in-laws family.Debi Das and Munna Das came to the Family Counselling Centre for sharing their present condition, activities, their problem, their happiness. The case has been closed, it is continues through Follow-Up by Family Counselling Centre.



Success Story no.-2

Success story of Mina Bauri and Manoj Bauri

This is a "Success Story" of Mina Bauri, who is a housewife and her husband Manoj Bauri, who is a Daily labour. Mina Bauri and Manoj Bauri were happily spend their newly married life. Few months later, her in-laws family members started quarrelling with Mina and and physically and mentally tortured her. Then Manoj kept Mina in Mina's father's house while she was pregnant for the first time, and since then her husband has not looked after Mina and has not taken care of any expenses or responsibilities. Mina Bauri then gave birth to a child. Mina debi then returned home with her baby. Due to childbirth, Mina debi becomes physically weak and unable to do the chores. Mina is oppressed by everyone in her family and her husband Manoj does not protest, but supports it. Many times her husband is also involved in this abominable act. This problem is often solved with the help of her family, relatives, neighbors and local political figures. In spite of that, many problems remain. For example, Minadebi then became second time pregnant. One day, absence of Manoj his father was drunk and shouting loudly. With this condition, he started pushing at the door of Mina's house at the midnight. Her mother-in-law did not come out to save Mina from the hand of her husband's while she was in her room. In the next morning, her neighbors informed to her father's house and her father and other family members came to take Mina and her son with them. Mina's family went to the police station to resolve the matter. In the presence of the police official, both family are

agreed to the resolution. The first few days, everything was going well. But after a few days, Manoj Babu completely stopped communicating with Minadebi and Manoj Babu would not take care of his wife and son and decided that he would not pay all the expenses. In this situation, Mina debi has become physically weak and has broken down mentally, thinking of herself and her son's future. Minadebi goes back to the police station to solve this problem but they did not get any solution. After hearing about the "Family Counselling Centre" from the Mahalla meeting organized at Dhoba para Primary School in Raghunathpur, Mina Bauri attended the Family Support Center on 07/07/2019 to address her problem.

The Counsellors Counsellor Mina Bauri. After Counselling, the Counsellors knew that she is emotionally brake down and find out the root of the problem.

Although the Counsellors reconciled them but the problem was very complicated which has not solved in the Police station and Mina Bauri's Father's family does not want any office due to their lack of knowledge and poverty. But the Counsellors Counsellor them and encouraged to solve the problem. Now, Mina Bauri and Manoj Bauri are living happily.

Now, Mina Bauri is better than before with her husband and other members in her in-laws family. Mina Bauri and Manoj Bauri came to the Family Counselling Centre for sharing their problems, their happiness and their activities. The case has been closed, it is continues To FCC through Follow up.
