## BRIEF HISTORY OF THE ORGANIZATION:

With the initiative of few young people of Khardah and its surrounding villages of Amta-I Block in the district of Howrah a new chapter was opened in the year 1990. Primarily it was a club for sports & cultural activities for the local youth which became a social development organization in the ensuing years. The youth members of the club realized their responsibilities not only to kick the football but also to roll the football in continuous process for developmental goal of their people in the area. The area is predominantly inhabited by the people of Scheduled Caste and Muslim community. Their backwardness in the social point coupled with prejudice, illiteracy, squalor and fatalism turned their switch off in the economic front too. In the year 1993 the club was registered in the name of Khardah Public Cultural & Welfare Association. KPCWA in short form. Since its registration, the youth with their own contribution and subscriptions from the members continued to serve people in the form of distributing books, organizing integration camps, helping poor students with coaching, helping widow and the old, distributing clothes, food etc. among the needy people of the area. Slowly various programmes were undertaken in collaboration with different Govt. & Non-Govt. Organizations for comprehensive development of people of the area.

From 1998 onwards the strategies began to transform from giving to participations of the people for planning of their destiny. The association gave more emphasis to the women and children as they are considered to be top priority sector. Hence, self help groups formations of women, their skill training and their holistic development had emerged as most salient sector of KPCWA's work. However it also had environment and education to concretize rural poor. The journey has just started for KPCWA and the goal is far reaching.

**VISION:** KPCWA visualize to bringing about a change in the society with equitable socioeconomic distribution with justice.

**MISSION:** - Cherish the path shown by various religious leaders, social reformers and change agents for an egalitarian society.

- Reach the un-reached with knowledge, values, information and know how.
- Make people join together for development of their own.
- Make development sustainable and replicable.

## SKILL TRAINING PROGRAMME UNDER “UTKARSH BANGLA”

In this financial year our organization has organized 3 batches of Skill Training on Self Employed Tailor Trade of apparel sector under UTKARSH BANGLA scheme under Paschimbanga Society for Skill Development (PBSSD), Technical Education, Training & Skill Development Department, Govt. of West Bengal, for employment opportunity to the Unemployed Youth.

(1) 3 batches of 85 days duration (340 hours) skill Training on Self Employed Tailor under UTKARSH BANGLA scheme for 30 nos of beneficiaries for each batch including one batch under SWOPNO BHOR Prakalpa for the KANYASHREE girls at training hall of our organization under Amta-I Development Block in Howrah District.



## JUTE INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT SCHEME (JIDS) TCPC :

In the financial year 2018-2019 our organization established a Training Cum Production Centre (TCPC) under Jute Integrated Development Scheme

(JIDS) at Khardah Bhagabati Devi Sangha, Khardah, Amta, Howrah in West Bengal for sustainable development of Jute collaboration with National Jute Board, Ministry of Textile,

Govt. of India. Now 12 nos. of trainees are making various designated jute fancy bag at production center of our organization and they earn money to help their family.

## SURVEY ON MUKTIDHARA TRAINED BENEFICIARIES

In this financial year our organization conducted a survey under Howrah, Hooghly and Paschim Medinipur District, West Bengal on the trained beneficiaries under Mukti Dhara Scheme in the

collaboration with PCC India. Our surveyors reached and surveyed 8452 nos of trained beneficiaries and surveyed on their present condition, and their present need for employment.



## OPEN SHELTER (HOME)

The Ministry of Women & Child Development, Government of India has sanctioned to run a Open Shelter for 25 nos. of boy child under the Integrated Child Protection Scheme collaboration with Department of Women & Child and Social Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal at Ward No.-25, Uluberia Municipality, Howrah District for the children in need in urban and semi-urban areas to provide care, support and rehabilitation for their holistic development. The purpose of the scheme is to create systems that will efficiently and effectively protect children. It is based on the cardinal principles of "Protection of child rights" and "Best interest of the child". Open Shelters in urban and semi-urban areas cater to all children in need of care and protection particularly beggars, street and working children, rag pickers, small vendors, street performers, orphaned, deserted, trafficked and run-away children, children of migrant population and any other vulnerable group of children Their age group of 6 – 18 years. The scheme essentially targets the homeless and street children ensuring protection of their rights and mainstreaming in the society by creating accessibility of developmental services to them.



### The main objective of the programme –

- To attract above-mentioned target group of children from their present vulnerable life situation to a safe environment.
- To guide these children away from high risk and socially deviant behaviors.
- To provide opportunities for education and develop their potential and talent.
- To enhance life-skills and reduce their vulnerabilities to exploitation.
- To carryout regular follow up to ensure that children do not return to vulnerable situations.
- Encourage involvement of social workers, community volunteers, peer educators, students and others. This will provide opportunity to people with skills and time to mentor, guide and improve the quality of life of these children.
- Prepare Individual Care Plan for each child which will be monitored by the DCPS from time to time

- To provide a space for children where they can play, use their time productively and engage themselves in creative activities through music, dance, drama, yoga & meditation, computers, indoor and outdoor games, etc.



## SCHEME FOR ADOLESCENCE GIRL (SAG KP)

Khardah Public Cultural & Welfare Association is an implementing partner of SAG-KP Convergence programme Aided by the Department of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare (WCD & SW) collaboration with CDPO Bagnan-I under Bagnan-I Development Block in Howrah district of West Bengal. It is unique initiative to convergence

SAG and Kanyashree Programme together in view of holistic development of adolescent girls from the age group of 11-18 years (both school going – going and out of school) to address their multi dimensional vulnerabilities in education, nutrition protection and health. This convergence programme is being implemented through ICDS cell.

Main Objective of the programme are to reduce different social vulnerabilities like school dropout, early marriage, trafficking. Mainstreaming out of school adolescent girls through linking them with Kanyashree Prakalpa. Skill Building by providing vocational training in convergence with Utkarsha Bangla.

## SANITARY MART PROGRAMME:

KPCWA is an empanelled organization of Howrah district for district level Sanitary Mart programme under SBM and MGNREGA. This financial year our organization has constructed 585 nos. of Individuals House Hold Latrine (IHHL) under Swachh Bharat Mission among Khardah & Udang-I Gram Panchayet under Amta-I Development Block in the district of Howrah. Organization also conducted awareness programme about mission of Swachha Bharat at various



Gram Panchayat area under Amta-I Development block. The main objectives of this



programme are Swachha Bharat, Clean India and Healthy India.

## CHARITABLE DISPENSARY

KPCWA has been running this charitable dispensary for a long time to give health services to the needy people of Khardah Gram Panchayat and Udang-I Gram Panchayats of Amta- I Block, Haturia-I Gram Panchayet of Bagnan-I block and Tulsiberia

Gram Panchayat of Uluberia-II Block in Howrah district around 4 km radius. Registered medical practitioner visit this center thrice in a week (Sunday, Monday & Thursday) from 3.00 P.M. to 6.00 P.M. for diagnosis of diseases of the patients and distribute

medicines almost free of cost. This financial year near about 1,650 nos. of poor and needy people of that area got benefited their health services during this span of time. Substantial support is given by Sitaram Jindal Foundation to run this center.

## OLD AGE HOME for WOMEN

KPCWA runs an Old Aged care Home for women in Jaipaiguri district of West Bengal. The main objectives of this initiatives are looking forward to a country which is committed to protect-

ing, caring and providing for the wellbeing of its elderly and to create an ecosystem where all Indians can age gracefully and live a life of dignity, with focus on concerted and synergized action

on the existing and emerging needs of the senior citizens. We provide regular health checkup, counseling, cultural meet for tool care of their physical & mental health.



## Livelihood Development Programme under CSR Project

Our Livelihoods Development Programme (LDP), supported by the JSW Cement Limited for livelihood Development at Salbani in the district of Paschim Medinipur, that aimed at improving the livelihoods of small land holder farmers, women providing for their households and youth seeking self-employment. The program consisted of enhancing access to financial services to all three segments; and for smallholders -improving agronomic practices for higher productivity, introduction of postharvest practices to protect the produce, local value addition for better Prices, strengthening the links in the value chains by linking them to markets, and for women and youth - training on entrepreneurship development to improve their business skills. In this financial year we have taken various activities for Community based Livelihood Development & Youth empowerment Programme of selected DIZ villages of Salbani in the district of Paschim Medinipur to enhance the livelihood status of the beneficiaries of five villages by adopting sustainable Farm & Non-Farm practices For Income enhancement & improved Livelihood through sustainable farm & non-farm practices. We have taken activities for Capacity building & empowering women through SHG promotion, financial inclusion. And make Convergence with Govt. and financial inclusion of people for better impact. All programme are taken to focus to capacitate and empower various community based organisation i.e. SHGs, Sangha, FPO etc. Effort made to develop marketing linkage,



bargaining collectively with the buyers, assuring quality standard etc. The Gram Panchayat level Sangha, facilitated securing support and mobilizing resources from different schemes and policies of the Govt. FPO leaders capacitated to develop effective linkage with departments or agencies i.e. NABARD, District Agriculture department, Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), Horticulture department, Agri. Marketing department, different marketing channels, outlets etc. We have organized Skill Training and handholding support to farmers for improved crop production & income enhancement. Given Input support to farmers to convert land to multi crop

through integrated farming model, alternative farming, introducing low water consuming. Organized Training & given input support for Bio- Fertilizer and Bio-pesticide production for SHG members and Establish market linkage to ensure that farmers are getting proper price for the crop. Organize Skill Training cum input support on livestock rearing for community members and Capacity building programme for SHGs for securing loan from bank, IPC with Govt. Depts., Banks, Insurance agencies and others. Organized Mass awareness programme on financial inclusion and IEC events for promoting financial inclusion.





## Outcome of the Project:

20 acres of land have been converted from mono-crop to multi crop with sustainable agriculture practice & more yield. Farmers increased practicing more than 1 crop therefore enhancement in income level.

Convergence made with Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) for mobilizing various resources

and improved agricultural practice.

Training & support done to 150 farmers on improved farm & non-farm practice in more than 170 acres of land with >20% more yield compared to FY2019-20.

Made awareness and Promotion of organic manure and bio-pesticide in agriculture for better return & ensuring

minimum support price (MSP). Capacity building & empowering women through financial inclusion, income generation training & hand holding support to 200 SHG women. 20 SHGs mobilized by involving 200 women with 100% credit linkage and convergence with Anandadhara (SRLM) Programme to get various Govt. facilities.

## FOOT BALL COACHING CAMP

In this financial Year KPCWA starts a Foot Ball Coaching centre at Khardah Kalikar Math Under Amta-I development Block in Howrah District with the assistance of the Department of Youth Services & Sports, Govt. of west Bengal under Khelashree Scheme . 60 Trainees under 6 years to 14years age group got trained from a State level coach. It will be our continuous mission to deliver a player-centred coaching environment to help yield technical, dynamic, intelligent, and good decision-making players. To expose children to the latest training methods. To produce technically excellent and innovative players, with exceptional decision-making skills. Using a player-centred comprehensive approach to coaching, we will empower our players to play a technical and exciting way, whilst remaining humble, respectful, and holding core "team and individual values" for the benefit of their own futures.



## CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL WOMENS DAY

KPCWA visualize creating an alternative people's centered society based on universally accepted human values of peace, justice, solidarity, equality. Works to empower women with dignity and develop

women as equal partners with men at all levels of the society for gender justice and equity. Like the previous years this also KPCWA celebrate INTERNATIONAL WOMENS DAY with the other activities, While

every day is a women's day, this particular day is marked to honor all the women and their achievements regardless of the divisions, whether national, ethnic, linguistic, cultural, economic or political.



## FAMILY COUNSELING CENTER (FCC)

Family Counseling Center has been stating from the year 2013. The Family Counseling Center situated at S.D.O Office complex, SHG/SE Building, Raghunathpur, Purulia, West Bengal, Pin Code- 723133 financially assisted by Ministry of Women & Child, Govt. of India through Central Social Welfare Board and West Bengal Social Welfare Board.

The Family Counseling Centre has been provide counseling, referral and rehabilitative services to women and children who are victims of atrocities, family maladjustments and social ostracism and also provide crisis intervention and trauma counseling in case of natural disasters. The Centre has been provided Awareness programme, Mohalla Meeting and mobilize public opinion on social issues affecting status of women at grass root level. The



FCC cases close collaboration with the local administration, police, courts, free legal aid cells, medical and psychiatric institutions, vocational training centre, short stay homes etc.

During this financial year many case treat and solve with the help of our two counselors like Domestic Violence-04 cases, Alcoholism/ Drug Addition-01 cases, Marital Maladjustment Spouse & In-laws-03 cases,

Personality difference-01 cases, Economic crises-01 cases, Extra Marital relation-04 cases, Depression-1 cases, Interference of Parents/in-laws-4 cases, Old age Problm- 2, Girl child birth -01 cases and property dispute-01 case. Total 54 nos. of cases was solved and 1 no. case referred to court and 21 nos. of cases pending out of total 76 cases but running for solving by the counselors.

## CRECHE PROGRAMME (NCS)

This scheme has been implementing by KPCWA aided by Directorate of ICDS, Department of Women & Child and Social Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal, since last twelve years for the benefit of working mothers of economically disadvantaged communities.

At present our organization has been running seven crèche centers, two at Khardah Gram Panchayat, one each at Sirajbati & Udang-I Gram Panchyat under Amta-I Block, one at Tapna Gram Panchat under Uluberia-I Block and one each at Ward No.-28 & Ward No.-20 under Uluberia Municipality area of Howrah District in West Bengal. Altogether 175



numbers of children, both boys and girls got enrolled in these centers. Apart from basic pre-primary education, they are given nutritious food regularly and health checkup services by registered medical practitioners in periodic intervals and also have sleeping facility, sports equip-



ments. Mothers are found very happy to see their children growing in these centers. In this Covid -19 Pandemic situation because of the centers are closed, therefore we provided nutrias Grocery kit to the parents of the children as per the Govt. order.



## ROGI SAHAYATA KENDRA

KPCWA has been running three nos. of Rogi Sahayata Kendra one at Brindabanpur BPHC under Uluberia-II Block, Joypur BPHC under Amta-II Block and Bagnan Rural Hospital under Bagnan-I Block in Howrah District with the help of our two Rogi Sahayaks in each Kendra since last four years collaboration

with office of the CMOH-Howrah, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal. The main objectives of the project are to help of the patient party and to set up information centre at the respective health facility, admission and treatment of RSBY and Swasthya Sathi

patients in BPHC/RH by our Rogi Sahayaks on helpdesk. This financial year 42 nos. of patients availed facilities at Brindabanpur BPHC, 137 nos. of patients availed facility at Joypur BPHC and 391 nos. of patients availed facility at Bagnan Rural Hospital under RSBY and Swasthya Sathi Scheme.

## RESPONSE TO COVID-19

The pandemic has exposed the immense vulnerabilities of the less privileged in India. While daily wagers were left dependent on charity, migrants walked home, communities faced shortages of everything from rations to medicines and the entire population watched, as a health and humanitarian crisis swept across the country.

It ruined the Socio-Economic Structure of all around the world. Many people became jobless. The agricultural labours, daily labours, Jari Workers, Van rickshaw pullars, small shop vendors, small businessman, bidi workers, masons etc. became financially in vulnerable situation due to their joblessness. The pandemic hitting families hard and turning life upside down. KPCWA feeling responsibility towards society and come forward to help the needy by continuously distributing monthly Grocery kit with essential commodities to the needy people of the villages under Amta-I, Uluberia-II Block and the slum areas of Uluberia Municipality in Howrah



district.

KPCWA distributed masks and sanitizer to the vendor of the markets, Toto drivers and among the people, Painted marks on the crowded places for maintaining social distancing.

## MICRO INSURANCE FOR THE POOR IN COLLABORATION WITH LIC, GoI

KPCWA has been running micro insurance programme for the poor peoples in collaboration with Life Insurance Corporation of India, Howrah division. The main objective of the programme is life assurance cover through life insurance

policy for the whole poor & needy people in India. This financial year, 622 numbers of new policies were sold and by the end of 31st March, 2021, almost 5123 nos. of peoples of our operational villages under identified blocks in Howrah

district were brought under Micro Insurance programme. Nominees of 3 nos. of policy holders got death claim money, 796 nos. of policy holders got maturity claim and 91 nos. of policies were surrendered for various reasons.



## AWARENESS GENERATION PROGRAMME

KPCWA works to empower women with dignity and develop women as equal partners with men at all levels of the society for gender justice and equity. We organized awareness programmes on Women Empowerment at Khardah Bhagabati Devi Sangha under Amta-I Development Block in Howrah district with active participants from deferent trade trainee of Utkarsha Bangla & SHG & SE training.

KPCWA is also working for the children so that organization has organized one awareness programme on Child Rights and Right to Education at Parijat, Ward No.-25 under Uluberia Municipality in Howrah district with active participants from identify destitute child, student and members of SHG. It also gives family counseling services to the women in need.

This financial year our organization organized an awareness programme on Health & Sanitation at our Meeting Hall under Khardah Gram Panchayat under Amta-I Panchayat Samity with active participants of common villagers.

In this financial Year our organization organized Public water conservation campaigns under Amta-I Development Block in Howrah District to raise awareness in all levels of society about the importance of saving water to cope with its scarcity and ensure sustainability. The aim is to change citizen attitudes and behavior to improve water use efficiency and to reduce unnecessary



water usage.

In this financial year the world going through a devastating pandemic situation for COVID-19. KPCWA make awareness among the people of different blocks of Howrah and Purulia district to maintain the social distancing and on usage of mask and the importance of washing hands. We Distributed mask and sanitizer to the mass people for their safety.

## CELEBRATION OF MAHATMA GANDHI BIRTH DAY AND ORGANIZATION FOUNDATION DAY

This financial year, KPCWA has celebrated Mahatma Gandhi's Birth Day Ceremony and our organization foundation day on 2nd October, 2020 at Meeting hall of Khardah Public Cultural & Welfare Association's Registered Building. There were staff and members near about 65 nos. of participants participated on that programme. Many resource persons were participated in this programme and they were delivered their valuable speech about Social Works on ideology of Mahatma Gandhi and discussion about achievement of our organization and working status as per social aspect of the organization on occasion of organization foundation day.





## PROMOTION OF SELF HELP GROUP (SHG) PROGRAMME

KPCWA has started promotion of Self Help Group (SHG) programme through bank linkage in the year 1998 for economically help to the poor and needy peoples in all categories of its operational areas to break out the vicious cycle of poverty.

Bank savings accounts of all

groups were opened at different bank branches. They have been generating saving and receiving credit from bank. Many members of all groups were skilled through skill development training programme collaboration with, DRDC, NJB, Department of SHG&SE and various agencies of both Govt.

of West Bengal and Govt. of India. Our organization encourages the group members to set up micro business and support them in marketing and promoting their products. Not only that our staff members also nurturing every groups and given handholding support twice in a month.

## YOGA CENTER (Vivekananda Yoga Center):

KPCWA has been running a Yoga Center namely "Vivekananda Yoga Center" at our organization premises from 21st June, 2015 on the occasion of International Yoga Day.

This financial year 43 nos. of trainees from 6 to 15 aged children has been yoga practice two days per week by our expert yoga trainer.

## KHARDAH PUBLIC LIBRARY

It was a long standing demand of local youth for starting one such library for furtherance of their studies in schools and colleges. Accordingly, KPCWA

started this library since last seven years. This financial year District Library Officer, Department of Library, Govt. of West Bengal has sanctioned financial

assistance for development of Khardah Public Library. Community peoples, students are encouraged to make use this center every day.

## CELEBRATION OF ANTARJATIK MARTI BHASHA DIVAS
